In May 2022, World Harvest held free medical treatment and leadership seminars at various community points, namely the Binong, Kampung Melayu, and Aceh Community with a total of 243 participants.

Free medical treatment is not only intended for foster children but also for families in the Binong, Kampung Melayu, and Aceh communities. Themed “You are Great” (“Kamu Hebat”), the leadership seminar presented by “Generasi Inspirasi” was held for foster children as a program to enriching children's character intelligence.



Progress of Wahana Harapan Tegal Angus Middle School and Vocational High School Building Development

World Harvest always strives to build qualified schools at the points of marginalized communities in Indonesia, where through the sponsorship of individual donors, organizations, or companies, a school can be built properly, both in terms of building construction and regarding school operational management.

One of the manifestations is the building development of the Wahana Harapan Tegal Angus Middle School and Vocational School. The main target of the development is the construction of 8 new classes, 1 student council room/student area. At this time the targets achieved are the construction of 2 new classes and 1 student council room / student area.

World Harvest always continues to equip school building facilities to support school learning activities supporting students in achieving their dreams.



The Progress of Kedaung Elementary School Building Development

Aiming to support schools in becoming an impact on the surrounding environment, World Harvest continues to strive to optimize the quality of schools, including in terms of facilities.

One of the tangible manifestations is the construction of the Kedaung Elementary School building. The main target of the development is the expansion of the land (150 m²), the addition of 2 rooms, the addition of 4 toilet rooms, the addition of 1 teacher's room, and a fireplace for 3 classrooms (addition of a light steel roof).

World Harvest continues to strive to support school learning activities as support for students to achieve their dreams by ensuring the comfort and safety of existing facilities.
